RPADPreamble:

Read: Notification of NCTE, New Delhi dated 1.1.2004 published in the Gazette of India Part III-Section 4 as No. 3 on 5.1.2004.

The National Council for Teacher Education has dispensed with the requirement of "No Objection Certificate(NOC)" from the State Government's/UTs for a period of three years in respect of institutions already recognised by NCTE for running a B.Ed course and seeking recognition to start a course or training in Elementary Teacher Education or from an existing Elementary Teacher Education Institution seeking permission to increase in intake in such a course.

D.K.T. Teacher Training Institute for Women, Amaravathipalayam, Perunthozhuvu P.O., Tirupur-641665, Coimbatore District, Tamilnadu which has been granted recognition by SRC-NCTE has submitted an application for increase in intake for Elementary (D.T.Ed) course by deriving the benefit of above said regulation on 28.12.2004.

The application for increase in intake of D.K.T. Teacher Training Institute for Women, Amaravathipalayam, Perunthozhuvu P.O., Tirupur-641665, Coimbatore District, Tamilnadu was considered by SRC-NCTE under section 15 of NCTE Act, 1993. In obedience to the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 26205 of 2005 an inspection of the institution was carried out on 29.11.2005. The inspection report was placed before SRC in its 105th meeting held on 2-3rd December, 2005. Upon consideration of the inspection team report and other documents furnished by the institution along with the application, the Committee is of the opinion that the institution prima facie, does not fulfill the norms and standards laid down by the NCTE in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly a notice was issued to the institution on 23.01.2006, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

The written representation submitted by the institution dated 6.2.2006 was placed before SRC in its 113th meeting held on 6-7th July, 2006. SRC considered the written representation submitted by the above institution and decided to issue recognition for an additional intake of 50 from the academic session 2006-07.

Hence the order.

Order

In terms of section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **D.K.T. Teacher Training Institute for Women, Amaravathipalayam, Perunthozhuvu P.O., Tirupur-641665, Coimbatore District, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for increase in intake of **Elementary(D.T.Ed)** course of two years from the academic session **2005-06** with an **additional intake of 50** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:


- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c. The institution has selected the **Principal** and **Eleven** teachers for the said course, which is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **D.K.T. Teacher Training Institute for Women, Amaravathipalayam, Perunthozhuvu P.O., Tirupur-641665, Coimbatore District, Tamilnadu** for **Elementary(D.T.Ed)** course of two years duration from the academic session **2006-07** with an annual intake of **100** students which includes the existing intake of **50** and an additional intake of **50**, subject to fulfillment of the following.

- a. The institution will ensure that **Twelve** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and Eleven teachers**) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of **100** students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course
- b. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

- c. FDR for endowment fund should be converted in the joint name of the Regional Director, SRC-NCTE and the management represented if it is not already done.
 - d. The institution should move to their own building within three years from the date of recognition of teacher training institute.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Directorate of Teacher Education Research and Training (DTERT) to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
